Convoy Rules

Drivers Briefing

- Remind Drivers of trip rules
- Any unique hazards to this trip
- Keep following vehicles in sight at all times
- Safe recovery techniques used
- Make sure the vehicle in front has cleared the hazard before proceeding
- VHF Radio Channel to be used

Recovery

- Make sure ONE person is in charge of vehicle recovery
- Make sure it is a safe way of doing the recovery
- Keep area around the recovery clear of onlookers
